Discipline Training

Po Leung Kuk Leadership Training Section organized adventure-based training programmes for F1 and F4 students and orientation session for F.1 parents. The learning motivation, class morale, student self management skills and sense of belonging among students are enhanced. Most students regarded such activities as memorable experience. Most teachers considered this function as worthwhile with proper follow up work done by class teachers concerned. F5 Students were organized to have a school campus overnight training for follow up and boosting of morale for HKDSE.

Footdrill training has been offered to F1 to F3 students. Positive changes were shown among the participants. It is expected that such trainings will continue to be launched for students at different levels.

Remedial Training for English, Chinese and Mathematics, Bridging Programmes for Chinese, English and Mathematics, Independent Enquiry Assistance to Senior Liberal Studies

Remedial programmes for English, Chinese and Mathematics are held throughout the year. The programmes help consolidate the foundations of core subjects among low achievers.

Bridging programmes for Chinese, English and Mathematics are held for new F.1 students during summer. Such preparatory courses better prepare new F.1 students to adapt to our language environment, in which Chinese is taught in Putonghua and other subjects taught in English. Students can also adapt better to our Mathematics education with the bridging programme conducted in summer. Besides, assistance is provided to students for writing better Independent Enquiry Reports for Liberal Studies.

Teaching Assistant

The Teaching Assistants help prepare materials and conduct remedial classes for Liberal Studies. Low achievers perform better and submit more quality assignment.

Part-time Clerical Assistant

The Assistant helps make records for Homework Detention Class and sends SMS to parents of those who fail to attend detention classes punctually. Workload of Curriculum Development Committee members has been eased and number of students who need to attend Homework Detention Class drops.

I.T. Assistant Technician

The Technician was not recruited and the tasks were performed by the I.T. technicians.
